➤ Racquetball or Wallyball

We have one court that is used for racquetball or wallyball. Booking privileges vary, and court fees are charged per person per hour; memberships are available. Please carry in clean shoes. Wallyball is played for either one or two hours at the same cost. Except for wallyball, two consecutive hours may not be reserved in advance. Residents have a seven-day booking priority; non-residents may only reserve the court 24 hours in advance. Proof of residency is required at every visit, and a waiver must be signed yearly. If you are under 18 years of age, a parent or legal guardian must sign the waiver.

➤ Weight Room

Our weight room contains Body Master equipment. We have a separate cardiovascular room with treadmills, lifecycle, stepper, and other equipment. You must be 14 years old and in high school to use the room unattended. Grade school children age 12 and older must have direct parental supervision. Yearly waivers must be completed and signed prior to working out. A parent or legal guardian must sign the waiver if you are not 18 years old. No one under the age of 12 years is permitted in the weight room. Proof of residency is required, and you must leave your driver's license or other I.D. at the desk on every visit. If you are not working out, you are not allowed in the weight room.

* There will be no charge for residents to use the splash pad for 2011!

Ages:

- Children must be at least 8 years of age to use the splash pad without an adult.
- A person at least 16 years of age must accompany any child who is less than 8 years of age.
- Children under 2 years of age will not be charged.
- Anyone 16 years of age and older will not be charged if they are accompanying a child under 8 years of age; otherwise you will be charged.

Season Passes:

Season passes for the splash pad are available only to residents. All non-residents must pay the daily fee. A water pass entitles you to the use of both the splash pad and the indoor swimming pool. A pool pass is only for the use of the indoor swimming pool. A Grandparent's water pass is available to resident grandparents whose grandchildren do not live in Rosemont. This pass allows a grandparent to bring their grandchildren to use either the splash pad or the indoor swimming pool. If you lose your pass, the cost to replace that pass is \$2.00 per pass. Family is defined as related persons living at the same address.

➤ **Splash Pad Area (cont.)**

The splash pad area will not open unless the temperature is at least 70 degrees. Further, if the ThorGuard lightning detection system is activated, there is visible lightning or it begins to rain, the splash pad area will be closed. We will wait 20 minutes, if these conditions remain unchanged, we will close for the session. In the event the splash pad is closed, we will offer no refunds.

Inside the splash pad area no one shall have any food, drink, alcohol, or gum. Also not permitted are pets, loud radios, strollers by the water and all infants must wear swim diapers, not regular diapers. The only footwear allowed by the water is water shoes. Anyone wishing to bring a group of 10 or more to the splash pad must call ahead; if you do not call, you may be refused entry.

If you are a resident bringing a non-resident who is your guest, a grandparent using a grandparent's pass, or an adult with a child under the age of 8 years old, you must stay in the splash pad area with your non-resident guest or the child you have brought. You may not bring these children and leave; when you leave he/she must also leave.

- ✓ A water pass entitles you to the use of both the splash pad and the indoor swimming pool.
- ✓ A pool pass is only for the use of the indoor swimming pool.
- ✓ A season water pass is available only to residents.
- ✓ If you lose your pass, the cost to replace that pass is \$ 2.00 per pass.

➤ Pool and Water Passes (cont.)

- ✓ A Grandparent's water pass is available to resident grandparents whose grandchildren do not live in Rosemont. This pass allows a grandparent to bring their grandchildren to use either the splash pad or the indoor swimming pool.
- ✓ A grandparent using a grandparent's pass must stay in the pool or splash pad area with your grandchildren. You may not bring them and leave; if you leave they must also leave.
- ✓ A family is defined as related persons living at the same address.
- ✓ Yearly passes go on sale each May 1st and half price passes are available on November 1st.
- ✓ Swim caps are required for anyone with shoulder length hair.
- ✓ Protected lap swimming is permitted only during the first 30 minutes each day the pool is open.

➤ Swimming Lessons

The Learn to Swim program offered by the Des Plaines Park District follows the American Red Cross guidelines and is designed to teach all levels of swimming skills. Lessons are held at the Rosemont pool from September through May. Please register your swimmer for the level most appropriate for his/her current ability. Swimmers will not be transferred to another level! Registration for all Learn to Swim programs end one week prior to the start date. **The next session held in Rosemont, starts in September 2011 and registration begins Monday, August 15 at the Des Plaines Park District Leisure Center, 2222 Birch Street (north of Touhy by Iroquois School).** Rosemont residents may register as residents and pay the lower resident rates. Please register for swim lessons separately from any other programs. If your class is filled, please complete the registration. Your name will be placed on a wait list. After registering, call the Rosemont Park District and tell us of your situation. For summer lessons, the Des Plaines Park District uses their own outdoor pools at Iroquois and Chippewa.

➤ Open Gym

You must be able to prove your age and residency; otherwise you may not be allowed in the gym or you will have to pay the non-resident fee. Children under the age of 6 may attend open gym during the grade school times; an adult must accompany them at all times. Check the schedule closely; you may not be allowed in the gym if your age is not scheduled. In the summer we do not offer non-resident high school time. **Please do not arrive earlier than your scheduled time; you are not allowed to just "hang out" in the lobby. Times are subject to change.**

The gym will be closed the following days: Monday, May 2 thru Sunday, June 12; Monday, August 8 thru Sunday, August 28. Starting Monday, June 13 we will follow the hours listed below. Starting Monday, August 29 we will return to the regular hours.

➤ **Day Camp**

Who: Rosemont resident children entering preschool through grade 8 in the fall of 2011. Day Camp preschool children must be entering Kindergarten in 2012 and be 4 years old by September 1, 2011. As much as we try, we do not always recognize everyone, especially if you are new to town. Please, when you come to register bring a gas, electric, or land phone (not a cell phone) bill to prove your residency. If there is a question of residency, you will not be able to register for camp. Only the parent or legal guardian can register a child for camp.

Extended Camp: This is an option, or an extra, you may choose for 2 weeks after regular camp. This option is not available to preschool or grades 7 and 8. The hours are the same as the regular camp except that everyone stays for lunch. Lunch is included in the cost. During extended camp, we have no field trips. Except for using the gym and swimming, all activities are at the park. The grades will be combined, and a minimum number of campers per grade must be met. You must register for this extra during registration week. If the minimum number is not met, extended camp will be cancelled.

*If your child cannot leave on his/her own at the end of the day, you must pick him/her up within 5 minutes after each day has ended, to avoid being charged the late fee. This fee must be paid before your child can return to Camp the following day.

Children not in supervised lunch must go home between 12:00 pm and 1:00 pm. Supervised lunch is available to everyone except preschool. You bring your own sack lunch and drink. Again this year grades 5 thru 8 will be combined into one group. This combined group will have classes and activities during the week the same as the single grade groups. They will enjoy three field trips on alternating Wednesdays. Children in grades 7 and 8 have the option to register for either a regular full week or a ½ week registration. With the ½ week registration your child attends camp Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Tuesday afternoon, as he/she chooses. Monday morning is the all-camp trip, Wednesday is a field trip for weeks 2/4/6, the remaining weeks on Wednesday the kids can choose to come for regular activities. Tuesday mornings are off and for the afternoon kids can sign up for ceramics. Fridays are off. We will charge a reduced registration fee, only if you are registering one child in grades 7 or 8 for the ½ week. Two children, regardless of grade, will pay the two-child fee.

The basic Day Camp registration fee is a fantastic deal – depending on your circumstance from 1 preschool child to 4 children registered, the hourly cost per child ranges from only \$.90 to \$2.85! You cannot beat it!

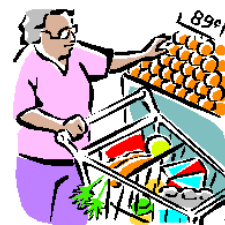

THOR GUARD LIGHTNING PREDICTION SYSTEM

The Rosemont Park District has installed a lightning prediction system. Thor Guardian is the first totally integrated advance warning system for lightning. The sensor monitors energy as far away as 15 miles and evaluates the potential for lightning within the area of approximately two miles in radius. When Thor Guardian senses hazardous conditions, the system automatically provides both audible and visual alerts. This system minimizes the potential for lightning related injuries and will be activated at Margaret J. Lange Park from April 1 through November 15. It is recommended that when the warning system is activated (one prolonged 15 second horn blast) the affected areas, ball fields, basketball courts, and playground areas be cleared and you should seek shelter. Activity may not be resumed until the all clear is given (3 short blasts of the horn and the strobe lights on the building go off). The strobe light signals are a continuing lightning alert. The strobe lights are orange; there is one on the south corner of the building and one on the north side of the building on the Thor Guardian indicator. Common sense still needs to be used, and if there is an unsafe weather condition, do not wait for the horn to blast; clear the area. Hours that the system is activated are 8:00 am to 10:00 pm, seven days a week from April 1 to November 15. The Thor Guardian horn is tested during the above months on the first Wednesday of each month at 11:00 am. Lightning is a severe hazard that must be viewed seriously! Park users should stop and seek shelter any time they believe lightning threatens them, even if a signal has NOT been sounded! Remember park users will be warned by one prolonged blast signaling a strong risk for lightning in the immediate area. The strobe light signals a continuing lightning alert condition. Three short horn blasts signals it is safe to return to the open outside areas.
