

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX LEVY INCREASE FOR
THE ROSEMONT PARK DISTRICT**

I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy for the Rosemont Park District for 2006 will be held on Monday, December 4, 2006 at 5:00 P.M., at Margaret Lange Park, Commissioners Meeting Room, 6140 N. Scott Street, Rosemont, Illinois 60018.

II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended or abated for 2005 were \$696,413.35.

The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for 2006 are \$720,091.00. This represents a 3.40 percentage increase over the previous year.

III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for 2005 were \$207,722.31.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for 2006 are \$226,687.00. This represents a 9.22 percentage increase over the previous year.

IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2005 were \$904,135.66.

The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2006 are \$946,778.00. This represents a 4.72 percentage increase over the previous year. Any notice which includes any information not specified and required by this Article shall be an invalid notice.

All hearings shall be open to the public. The corporate authority of the taxing district must explain the reasons for the proposed levy and shall permit persons desiring to be heard an opportunity to present testimony within reasonable time limits as the authority determines.
